I International Workshop on Aedilitian Epigraphy: “Talking walls. Aedilitian inscriptions in the Iberian Peninsula and the Mediterranean”

The Archivo Epigráfico de Hispania in collaboration with **DOCEMUS-CM (S2015-HUM/3377)**, **CITHARA (HAR2015-65649-C2-1-P)** and **EVA (HUM-2017 T1/5650)** are proud to announce the I International Workshop for epigraphists, which will take place in the **Facultad de Geografía e Historia, Universidad Complutense de Madrid**, to be held on **April 8, 9, 10, 2019**.

Due to the support of the Classics Department at Universidad Complutense, as well as the SELAT (Sociedad de Estudios Latinos) and the Ganímedes Association, this brand new conference endeavours to become a suitable space for intellectual and scientific debate among young scholars. Proposals should discuss Mediterranean epigraphy in any of its variants (e.g. Latin, Greek, Paleo-hispanic, Semitic or Romance).

The workshop encourages scholars to present their PhD projects on aedilitian Mediterranean epigraphy. Among other issues, the Scientific Committee will pay special attention to the following **subjects**:

- a) Epigraphy in the context of dating.
- b) Epigraphy and architecture (functionality).
- c) Inscriptions in the context of Medieval communication.
- d) Inscriptions in relation to the visual and graphic elements that embellish the building.
- e) Epigraphy in the context of Ritual studies.

Presentations will last no longer than 20 min per participant, followed by a brief discussion moderated by an expert on the subject. The official languages in the workshop are Spanish, Portuguese, French, Italian, English and German. Proposals will be submitted by filling the form in the website of the Archivo epigráfico de Hispania (www.archivoepigraficodehispania.com), including an abstract and sending it to the following email: jornadasepigraficas@gmail.com

Deadline for submissions will be **13 Jan. 2019**. Register fee for participants will be 20€. Other Attendants will not pay any fee.

Submissions will be assessed by the Scientific Committee, formed by Carmen Barceló, Felisa del Barrio, María Luisa del Barrio, Marisa Bueno, Estela García Fernández, Paloma Guijarro, María del Rosario Hernando, Eugenio Luján, Fátima Martín Escudero, Javier de Santiago e Isabel Velázquez.

The workshop Keynote speakers will be announced in a future communiqué.

Last, the organizing committee will coordinate a collective, peer-reviewed volume with articles that result from papers presented during the sessions.
